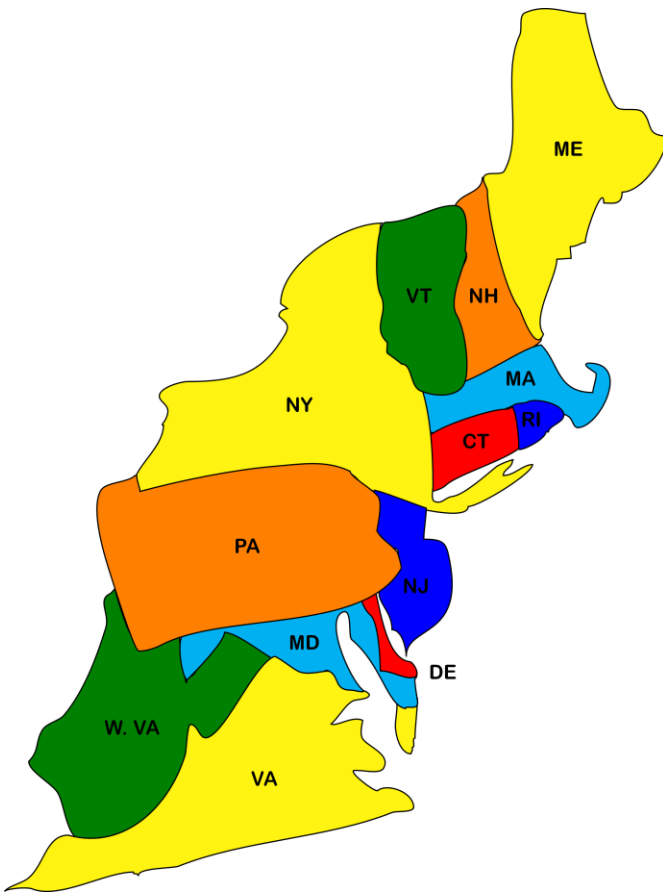

2011 North East US Active Shooter/Violence Activity

Since the beginning of the year 2011 to the present, there have not been any active shooter incidents reported in the North East.

Activity across the US

To date we have researched and recorded 3 Active Shooter /Violence incidents, reported in the news, across the US.

8 JAN: AZ, Male suspect intends to assassinate a U.S. representative, takes 6 live, injures 12 at a constituent meeting outside a grocery store. The suspect is taken into custody immediately after the shooting.

25 MAR: IN, Incident took place at a Middle School. Male teenage suspect, an expelled student, shot and injured another male student. The suspect was taken into custody about an hour after the incident. Schools in the area were put on lockdown while the investigation was in progress.

12 APR: TN, Incident took place at a High School and is believed to be gang-related. One female student (not the intended target of the shooting) was shot suffering a non-life threatening injury. Five suspects were detained and no further lockdown took place.
