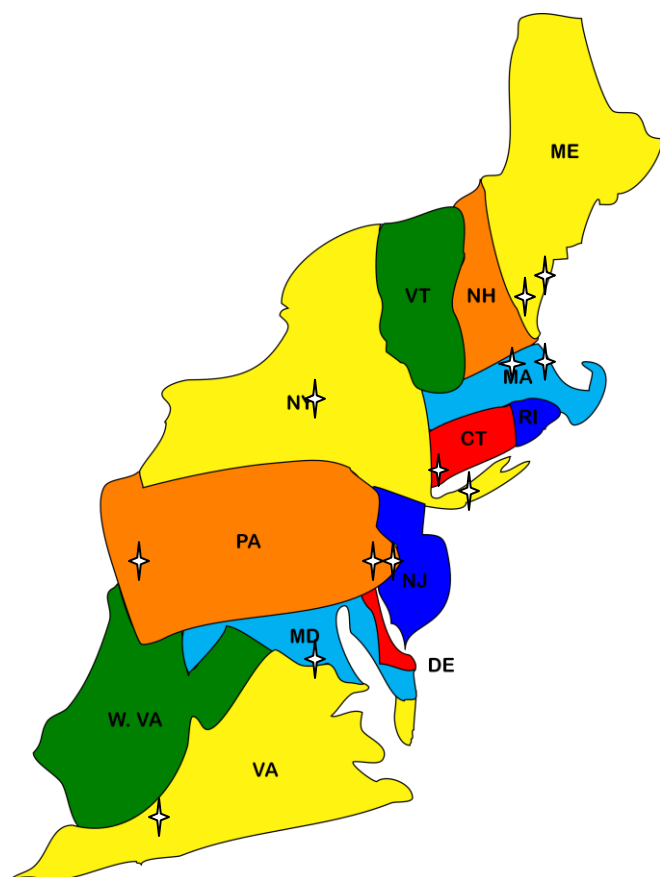

Additional Info:

Of these 91 incidents, 80 suspects were injured or killed by police, 51 suspects were taken into custody, 3 incidents resulted in 'at large' suspects.

11 incidents resulted in civilian/police fatalities and 25 resulted in civilian/police injuries.

103 suspects were male, 5 female and 1 incident the suspects were unidentifiable.

10 incidents involved hostages; no incident involved explosives.
